

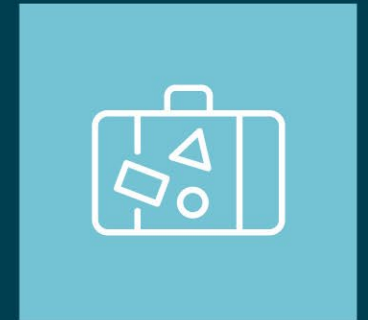

Funding will support:

- Skills development in sectors where demand exists
 - hospitality, care and construction
- Skills development in emerging areas
 - digital, advanced manufacturing, green jobs
- Focused skills interventions for disadvantaged groups
 - females, young people, disabled, those with health issues
- Employed and Unemployed individuals
- Opportunities arising from AGD capital investments
- Training not supported from existing funds
- Accredited and non-accredited training opportunities



Ayrshire Skills Investment Fund

Funding will support:

- 500 Employed participants
- 500 Unemployed participants
- 300 participants gaining an accredited qualifications
- 300 Businesses: workforce skills development
- Fund currently in development:
 - Anticipated launch: October – December 2022
 - Anticipated end date: 31st March 2028
 - Business case to be approved
